The LGBTQ Program

The Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual, Trans, Queer (LGBTQ) Program is funded by the United Way of Peel Region. Clients may refer themselves or be referred by other agencies.

Eligibility Criteria: Participants must self-identify as being a member of the LGBTQ community and either live or work in the Region of Peel.

- Family Problems
- Intergenerational and Cultural Conflict
- Harassment and Bullying
- Social Isolation

Family Services of Peel provides counselling, support for victims of abuse, employment support services, supports for people with developmental disabilities and education programs.
