Coordinator of PCSA and Director of Client Services of FSP developed and submitted proposal to Ontario Trillium Foundation.

Proposal was submitted with a Community Partnership that included FSP (as lead), with PCSA and Peel Committee Against Women Abuse as community partners.

Proposal was successful with a start date of Summer 2013.

Organizing...

Hit some road bumps in the latter part of 2013 and earlier part of 2014.

PCSA funding was removed, the committee became non-functioning, consequently the Community Partnership was jeopardized.

OTF funding on hold as we re-configured and re-grouped.

FSP kept working on the project.
